WHEREAS, the County received applications for farmland preservation from the owners of the above referenced farms between the years 2013 and 2017; and

WHEREAS, the County first submitted these farms to the State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC) for cost-share funding, but the SADC elected not to participate in these the preservation of these farms due to the farms' location within the Pohatcong Groundwater Contamination Area; and

WHEREAS, the County thereafter sought cost-share funding from the New Jersey Highlands Council's Highlands Open Space Partnership Funding Program (HOSP) in 2018 and the County subsequently received notification from the Highlands Council that the above referenced farms were approved for approximately 50% cost-share, including 50% cost-share towards valuations determined using the Highlands Dual Appraisal method set forth in N.J.S.A. 13:8C-38.j(1); and

WHEREAS, the source of funding for the HOSP changed after the initial round(s) and began using funding administered by the United States Fish and Wildlife (USFW); and

WHEREAS, the County was recently informed that the USFW funds cannot be used as 50% cost-share towards valuations determined using the Highlands Dual Appraisal method set forth in N.J.S.A. 13:8C-38.j(1); and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2021, the Warren County Agriculture Development Board (CADB) voted unanimously to request that the Warren County Board of County Commissioners forego seeking HOSP funds on the above referenced farms and to fully fund the acquisition of farmland preservation development easements on these farms using only County Open Space Trust Funds; and

- (5) increasing development pressures require quick and aggressive action to save farmland.

RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO THE REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM ACT S-3030/A-4848

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Reproductive Freedom Act was introduced in the Senate on October 8, 2020, as S-3030, and in the Assembly on October 20, 2020, as A-4848; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 will make New Jersey a destination for those seeking state funded abortions without restriction, and thus create an unreasonable financial burden on New Jersey taxpayers as the bill will apply to "every individual in the State, regardless of whether they are domiciled in the State, and regardless of whether or not the individual is under State control"; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 removes all restrictions on all abortions, including late-term abortions, throughout the entire nine months of pregnancy, which contradicts the Supreme Court's opinion in Roe v. Wade (1973) that was reaffirmed in Planned Parenthood v. Casey (1992); and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 enshrines in law that living babies in the womb capable of feeling pain have no rights at any stage of pregnancy, even if they are viable and at full-term. The bill specifically states that "a fertilized egg, embryo, or fetus shall not have independent rights under the laws of this state"; and

WHEREAS, S3030/A-4848 invalidates existing laws and prohibits the future adoption of all laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, resolutions, policies, standards or parts thereof, that conflict with the provisions of the bill; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 removes medical community oversight by expressly invalidating all rules and regulations promulgated by the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners which regulate and apply exclusively to termination of pregnancy; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 puts women in danger by permitting non-physicians to perform abortions, and restricts individual freedom of choice by invalidating New Jersey's conscience clause which has been in effect since 1974 which protects the right of individuals to refuse to perform or assist in abortion procedures; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 voids the New Jersey Safe Haven Infant Protection Act by exempting from prosecution individuals charged with "terminating or attempting to terminate the individual's own pregnancy; or acting or failing to act in any manner, with respect to the individual's own pregnancy, based on the potential or actual impact on the individual's own health or pregnancy." The bill eliminates the requirement that a medical legal death investigation be conducted in a case where a fetal death occurs without medical attendance." Such language grants immunity from prosecution for cases, including, but not limited to, the "Prom Mom", where infants have been born alive and left to die, or through a deliberate act, are killed; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 imposes an undue financial burden on taxpayers by mandating an annual allocation of taxpayer funding of Planned Parenthood, a private entity, under Title X in the state budget; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 will impose higher premiums on health care for state residents by requiring all insurance carriers to provide full coverage for abortions; and

WHEREAS, S-3030/A-4848 gives the state the power to define what is or isn't a "religion" by requiring "religious employers" to request an exclusion from abortion-related health care coverage, if the required coverage conflicts with the religious employer's "religious beliefs and practices" as determined by the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren oppose the passage of S-3030/A-4848, and urge the New Jersey Legislature to oppose this legislation; and

RESOLUTION

On motion by , seconded by , the following resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren at a meeting held on August 11, 2021.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12

WHEREAS, the Warren County Board of County Commissioners is subject to certain requirements of the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A.* 10:4-6, et seq., and

WHEREAS, the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A.* 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board hereby excludes the public in order to discuss such matters. The general nature of the subjects to be discussed are as follows:

- (1) *Matters Required by Law to be Confidential:* Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
- (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
- (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds:

Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.

- (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of possible violations of the law.
- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or many become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance or promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.
- (9) Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bearing responsibility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board shall disclose to the public, as soon as practicable, the contents of the discussions after the final disposition of the matters discussed.
