## **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE 2022-A**

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND THE APPROPRIATION OF \$ 7,225,089 FROM THE WARREN COUNTY GENERAL CAPITAL FUND BUDGET FOR SUCH PURPOSES

The capital improvements or purposes described in this Ordinance are hereby authorized as General Improvements to be made by the County of Warren, NJ. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$7,225,089 from the General Capital Improvement for the said improvements or purposes:

The purposes described in this Ordinance are not Current Expenses and are for the improvements or purposes as stated above and can be funded by the issuance of bonds if they were not being permanently funded by capital funds on hand. These appropriations are made as a result of the need to improve existing county infrastructure and facilities.

The maximum amount of money to be appropriated for said purposes is \$7,225,089 no part of which is to be borrowed.
