RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE WARREN COUNTY VOTING ACCESSABILITY ADVISORY BOARD AND DESIGNATE THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Pursuant to N.J.S.A 19:8-3.7, the governing body in each county shall establish a Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, said committee shall undertake an inspection of each polling place in the county and shall receive notice of complaints filed with the Division of Elections that concern the accessibility of polling places: and

WHEREAS, said committee shall consist of between seven and eleven members, including the four members of the county board of elections: and three or more public members, including a member of the county governing body, as appropriate; at least one individual with a disability: at least one individual trained in the provisions of the federal "Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990"; and if the governing body so elects, any other person deemed able to be of assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Warren as follows:

- 1. The Warren County Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee is hereby established in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:8-3.7. The Committee shall consist of not less than seven (7), and no more than eleven (11), total members, which shall include:
 - a. The four (4) members of the County Board of Elections; and
 - b. Three (3) or more public members, to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners as follows:
 - i. One (1) County Commissioner;
 - ii. At least one (1) individual with a disability;
 - iii. At least one individual trained in the provisions of the federal "Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990" (42 U.S.C. § 12101 et seq.). (N.J.S.A. 19:8-3.7).
- 2. Each appointed member of the Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners.
- 3. The Voting Accessibility Advisory Committee shall assist the Warren County Board of Elections in interpreting and implementing the provisions of the applicable provisions of Title

19 of the New Jersey Annotated Statutes and Title 15, Chapter 10 of the New Jersey Administrative Code. The duties of the Committee shall also include evaluating and undertaking physical inspections of all polling locations, identifying and developing a list of polling places found to be inaccessible, reporting its findings to the Secretary of State and County Board of Elections in the manner and time required by law, consulting with the County Board of Elections to determine alternative polling places or actions needed to make existing facilities accessible, receiving and reviewing complaints filed from the County with the Division of Elections concerning accessibility of individuals with disabilities and the elderly and otherwise performing any and all duties and functions tasked to the Committee.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REORGANIZATION AND REDUCTION OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE WARREN COUNTY PEQUEST RIVER MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AND THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren, then the Board of Chosen Freeholders, (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "County Board of Commissioners" or "Board of Commissioners") adopted a resolution on May 28, 1969, creating the Warren County Pequest River Sewerage Authority ("Sewerage Authority") pursuant to the Sewerage Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:14A-1, consisting of five (5) members appointed by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 1970, the County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution amending the resolution creating the Sewerage Authority and providing for the reorganization of the Sewerage Authority as a Sanitary Sewer District Authority pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:36A-1, and thereby reestablished as the Warren County Pequest River Sewer Authority ("Pequest Sewer Authority"), composed of five (5) appointed members; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature subsequently passed a bill into law providing for the reorganization, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:14B-6, of a Sanitary Sewer District Authority theretofore established as a County and Municipal Utilities Authority Law, N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1, *et seq*. ("CMUAL"); and

WHEREAS, under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-4, the County and Municipal Utilities Authority expressly required that the members of the existing authority be reappointed as members of the reorganized CMUAL; and

WHEREAS, the CMUAL expressly allows for the expansion of the membership of the authority by resolution of the County Commissioners from five (5) to either seven (7) or nine (9) members; and

WHEREAS, in response to the aforementioned statutory amendments, on May 24, 1978, the County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution providing for the reorganization of the Pequest Sewer Authority and for the establishment of the Warren County Pequest River Municipal Utilities Authority ("PRMUA") as a County and Municipal Utilities Authority, consisting of five (5) members and the reappointment of those members of the existing Pequest Sewer Authority; and

WHEREAS, in legislation subsequently adopted under the so called "general law", the State Legislature specifically elected to expand the non-charter counties, like the County of Warren, to reorganize, alter and abolish its statutorily established officers, board, commission and authorities.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.2 specifically provides that the powers granted "shall be construed as liberally as possible in regard to the county's right to reorganize, alter or abolish its agencies"; and

WHEREAS, "county agencies" is defined expansively by N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.2 to be inclusive of "[a]ll county offices, boards, commissions, and authorities, authorized or established by statute," other than those "boards and offices" listed in N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.3(b) and other than educational institutions authorized or established pursuant to Title 18A of the New Jersey Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the "boards and offices" which are excluded by virtue of their inclusion in N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.3(b) are essentially limited to that of constitutional offices, particularly, "the county board of taxation, county board of elections, jury commissioners of the county, county register of deeds, county clerk, surrogate, county superintendent of elections, and sheriff"; and

WHEREAS, evidently County and Municipal Utilities Authorities are not among those "board and offices" listed under N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.3(b) and thereby the PRMUA is "considered to be [a] county agenc[y] for purposes of [N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.2];" and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren is empowered, in its discretion, to reduce the membership of the PRMUA by resolution pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.2; and

WHEREAS, as originally constituted, and at certain times thereafter, the service area of the Sewerage Authority, Pequest Sewer Authority and/or PRMUA was comprised the Town of Belvidere, Township of Hope, Township of White, Township of Oxford, Liberty Township and portions of Allamuchy Township, Blairstown Township, Frelinghuysen Township, Knowlton Township, Independence Township, Mansfield Township and Washington Township; and

WHEREAS, currently the PRMUA service area is limited to that of the Town of Belvidere, Township of Oxford and Township of White, with the Town of Belvidere and the Township of Oxford being the two (2) biggest users;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Warren as follows:

- 1. The membership of the Warren County Pequest River Municipal Utilities Authority is hereby is reorganized and reduced to consist of five (5) total members to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners in accordance with the terms of the May 24, 1978 resolution authorizing the reorganization and establishment of the PRMUA as a County and Municipal Utilities Authority.
- 2. Each member of the Warren County Pequest River Municipal Utilities Authority shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners to serve for the terms, and under the conditions, provided by statute and shall be comprised, based on the usage of the municipalities within the PRMUA sewer service area, of:
 - a. Two (2) members residing within the Town of Belvidere;
 - b. Two (2) members residing within the Township of Oxford; and
 - c. One (1) member residing within the Township of White.

3. The Warren County Board of County Commissioners hereby reappoints the following existing members of the PRMUA to the terms corresponding to the terms of members first appointed:

WHEREAS, the Warren County Board of County Commissioners is subject to certain requirements of the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A.* 10:4-6, et seq., and

WHEREAS, the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A.* 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board hereby excludes the public in order to discuss such matters. The general nature of the subjects to be discussed are as follows:

- (1) *Matters Required by Law to be Confidential:* Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
- (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.

- (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
- (6) Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property: Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any investigations of possible violations of the law.
- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or many become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance or promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.
- (9) Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty: Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bearing responsibility.
